

ORDINANCE NO. 2008 - 01

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DUMPING OF TRASH OR REFUSE WITHIN THE CITY OF BULL SHOALS, ARKANSAS; PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BULL SHOALS, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, association, company or corporation to dump or throw any form of trash, refuse, cans, bottles, garbage, paper, rags or any other kind or form of trash or garbage upon the streets, alleys, byways or easements of the City of Bull Shoals, Arkansas.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm, association, company or corporation who violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100 00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500 00).

SECTION 3. The City Police Department is hereby authorized to enforce the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. Severability

If any provision, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance, or the application thereof shall be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not effect the other provision of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application and to this end the provision of this ordinance are declared severable.
