

ORDINANCE NO. 2008 - 14

DAMAGE AND/OR DEBRIS TO PUBLIC PROPERTY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BULL SHOALS, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. No person(s), firm, association, company or corporation intentional or unintentionally shall cut, injure, mark, deface, destroy and/or damage any public property which includes, but is not limited to, buildings, their components, sewer, water pipes, hydrants, sign, sign post or other City property, or any tree, grass, shrub or walk in any public way or public park.

SECTION 2. No person(s), firm, association, company or corporation intentional or unintentionally shall cause and/or leave any debris on any public walk, street, alley and/or any other public property. For the purpose of this ordinance debris includes, but is not limited to dirt/mud from construction sites, snow pushed and/or shoveled into public way, cement mixer spills.


SECTION 3. Upon conviction any person(s) firm, association, company or corporation who violates the provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor. Under the provisions of Arkansas Statute 15-55-504, upon conviction, shall be fined in any sum of not less than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each violation, plus the cost to replace, repair and/or clean up, which will include parts, material, equipment usage, gas, labor cost and miscellaneous expenses. If the violation is continuous in nature in respect to time, the fine shall not be less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) for each day that it may be unlawfully continued, plus the cost to replace, repair and/or clean up, which will include parts, material, equipment usage, gas, labor cost and miscellaneous expenses.


SECTION 4. Enforcement of this Ordinance shall rest with the Bull Shoals Police Department.

SECTION 5. If any provision, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance, or the application thereof shall be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not effect the other provision of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application and to this end the provision of this ordinance are declared severable.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall be in full immediate effect upon passage and posting


