ORDINANCE 2025-13

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING THE CITY POLICE CHIEF OF THE CITY OF BULL SHOALS, ARKANSAS

WHEREAS, the City of Bull Shoals, Marion County, Arkansas seeks to address the terms of employment for the position of chief of Police for the City of Bull Shoals,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BULL SHOALS, MARION COUNTY, ARKANSAS, THAT

- 1) It will take a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council to remove or demote a person from the position of Chief of Police for the City of Bull Shoals
- 2) The Chief of Police for City of Bull Shoals is required to live within the city limits of Bull Shoals, and, as a salaried employee, is required to work between 40 and 50 hours per week if the police department has fewer than five police officers. If the police department has five or more officers, the weekly working hours requirement shall instead align with Arkansas law for uniformed employees.
- 3) This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.
