Therefore, be it resolved, that the Mayor of Bull Shoals, Arkansas is hereby authorized to submit an application of formal request to the Arkansas Rural Development Commission for purposes of securing state grant funds in the amount of up to \$100,000.00 to aid and assist the Bull Shoals Community in executing the proposed project described herein and that the Recorder/Treasurer of Bull Shoals is further authorized to administer the grant funds for the same project.
